HORSE TRIALS CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 1. The country will be divided into eight regions. Each of the eight regions will be asked to hold a qualifier to determine which riders will compete in the championship classes.
- 2. The top four rider & horse combinations from each graded class at each regional qualifier will go forward to the championship final. If a rider & horse combination has already qualified at a previous qualifier, the next best placed rider will go forward to the final.
- 3. If a qualified rider cannot compete at the championship final, the placed will be offered to the next best placed rider at their respective qualifier.
- 7. Non qualified riders may compete in national classes including young horse. Rider & horse combinations must have completed a horse trials, hunter trials or cross jump competition after the 1st May before the national event.
- 8. A club team championship is open to teams of 4 riders from one club competing in either the championship or non-championship (national) classes excluding the young horse class.

Teams must consist of 3 or 4 riders representing no less two grades. Please note that team members must be from the same club.

The best three scores will count towards the teams overall score.

9. Horses: Horses must be entered under their registered name as described on their passport.
