## SHOW JUMPING LEAGUE & TEAM CHALLENGE

### Novelty Classes

Both our novelty classes will be Accumulator competitions, albeit with different rules concerning the timing. We're also delighted to say that we will have serious prizes for these classes rather than novelty prizes, thanks to generous support from Myson.

### Welcome Stakes

Primary riders should note that we will not be accepting HC entries in the Welcome Stakes. The clear round jumping will serve as the warm up for the Primary class. It will be at a forgiving height so there's no need for anybody to panic.

### Team Show Jumping Challenge

As regards the rules for the Team Challenge, we will work on the basis of the AIRC team show jumping rules with the following alterations:

1. Teams are made up of a rider from each of the P, AP and I grades. The fourth rider may be from any grade.
2. Teams must be entered and paid for in full (€10) before the beginning of the Primary class.
3. There will be just one round of jumping and this takes place as part of the respective grade's individual class.
4. In the case of an equality of faults, the Intermediate rider will contest a jump off against the clock. This will be a separate jump off to that for the Intermediate class and will take place after the completion of the individual classes (before the I/AI/O Accumulator).
5. The presentation of the cup will take place after the completion of the individual classes (before the I/AI/O Accumulator). We would very much appreciate if the winning team could receive the cup fully mounted on the correct horses. Gamble Photography will be present at the show and we would like to get good photographs of the presentation for the benefit of both the winning club and the show's supporters.

### Directions to the Show

Finally, a word on directions to the show. There are major roadworks on the way out from Derry and the maps sent previously are no longer fully up to date. From Derry, make sure you follow the signs for Coleraine/Limavady/Airport and take the turn for Donnybrewer at the roundabout before the airport. There's a temporary AA sign for Donnybrewer at an earlier roundabout but continue until you see the permanent sign at the next one. Make the turn there. There'll be AIRC signs in place from this point on. If you get as far as the Airport roundabout, you've gone too far so retrace your steps.
