The landowners, their agents nor the organisers shall accept any liability for any damage, loss or accident to any person whether competitor or spectator, to any animal, vehicle or property howsoever caused in connection with this event.

All competitors must be current AIRC members, competitors must present their card and horse passport when collecting their numbers.

The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Competitors who in the opinion of the officials are considered unsafe for any reason will not be allowed to continue to the next phase.

Safety officers and stewards are there for the protection of competitors and spectators and give their time voluntarily, please obey them at all times and show respect and consideration to all officials, failure to do so will be subject to AIRC disciplinary action and immediate elimination from the competition.

Competitors must report to the call up steward at each phase with ample time to allow for tack inspection. It would greatly assist tack stewards if hats are tagged, this can be done when collecting numbers.

Competitors must supply own number bib.

Riding Hats

It is compulsory that riding hats/ crash hats conform to the following standards:-

EN 1384 (it is strongly recommended that it is prefixed by BS) XC no fixed peak allowed.
PAS 015, ASTM F 1163-95 or ASTM SNELL E95 (SEI)

Identifying label must be stitched in and hats must be securely fastened at all times when mounted.

Body protectors:- level 3 (purple) or higher compulsory for XC and recommended for SJ .

Competitors must wear a correctly fitted hunting stock or neck support for XC and a medical armband with photo identification.
