AIRC REGIONAL TRAINING DAY 2013 ORGANISED BY DONEGAL CLUBS

Dear Secretary,

Please find attached information on the upcoming AIRC Regional Training Day which is being held at Cloncaw Equestrian Centre, Glaslough, Co. Monaghan on Sunday 28th July 2013 which I would be grateful if you could circulate to your members. Cloncaw Equestrian Centre is located approximately 1 hour 40 mins from Letterkenny. This was the location of our regional training day 2 years ago and proved to be an excellent venue with a quiet indoor arena for dressage, a grass showjumping paddock with a separate outdoor sand arena for warming up and a cross country course that is ideal for your first introduction to xc or if you're looking for a knee trembling blast around the course!

We are hoping to get the first lesson underway at 11am sharp. Lessons will run for 1 - 1.5 hours (depending on numbers) each with a maximum of six people per lesson. Members may avail of up to 3 lessons per horse with top trainers at a bargain price of ≤ 25 .

Training will be available in Show Jumping, Dressage and Cross Country and members can compete in either three different disciplines or two or three of the same. Please ensure members have indicated on the entry form which disciplines they wish to compete in and their current grade and the grade they would like to train at. For those who have never tried xc before, please put "intro" as the training grade.

For anyone training in cross country, skull caps and body protectors are mandatory. For other disciplines, body protectors are advised but are at the riders discretion. Correct footwear is essential. An ambulance will be on site for the duration of the training day and fingers crossed their services will not be needed!!

Onsite stabling is available on the Saturday night for those who wish to travel up the day before (perhaps for a hack around the Castle Leslie Estate which is very close by – members who wish to do this should arrange this with the Equestrian Centre at the Castle themselves) at a cost of €20 which also covers you for all day Sunday or if members want a stable for use inbetween lessons on the Sunday, the cost is €10. Stabling should be booked by members directly with me on 087-2128031 and should be paid for on the day.

Refreshments will be available in Cloncaw's café including tea, coffee and scones on arrival and a hot lunch with cake / traybakes at a maximum of €10 per person – this may be able to be subsidised although we are unable to confirm this at present.

Entries should be made on the official form (one per member) and a club cheque made out to Donegal Gaeltacht Riding Club to cover all entry fees should be forwarded to Rachael Mc Crossan, 18 The Maples, Lismonaghan, Letterkenny, Co.Donegal to arrive no later than Friday 19th July 2013. Lesson times for individual members will be forwarded to club secretaries no later than Wednesday 24th July 2013 by email.
