



IMPORTANT CHANGES FOR SPORTSMAN/ AMATEUR RIDERS!

As from 7 April 2014, new Sportsman Rules will come into effect as follows:

- Sportsman classes will now be called **Amateur Eventing classes**: CNC1* Amateur, EI 100 Amateur, EI 90 Amateur
- Amateur riders can now compete in these classes from 18 years of age
- **CNC1* A** (Sportsman A) will compete the novice dressage, show jumping and cross country
- **EI 100 A** (Sportsman B) will compete EI 100 dressage, show jumping and cross country
- **EI 90 A** (Sportsman C) will compete EI 90 dressage, show jumping and cross country
- A horse with any points can compete in these classes
- Horses must be a minimum of 4 years of age for the EI 90 Amateur and 5 years of age for EI 100 Amateur
